In accordance with Section No. 186 of the Tiruchirappalli City Municipal Corporation Act, 1994, the revised estimates for the year 2021-22 and the budget estimate for the year 2022-23 have been approved by the Special Officer and Commissioner of the Tiruchirappalli City Municipal Corporation in the Resolution No. 23 dated 25.01.2022.

The objectives and implementation of the new council have been planned based on the long-standing demands, needs and financial status of the Tiruchirappalli Municipal Corporation, and based on that, the revised budget estimate for the year 2022-2023 has been prepared.

Under the leadership of Thalapathi, the Honorable Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, good governance has been established in Tamil Nadu and one year has been completed successfully. Our Municipal Administration Minister, Hon. Mr. K.N. Nehru, is a great achievement for our district. Due to the efforts of our Municipal Administration Minister, various projects have been sanctioned for the Tiruchirappalli City Municipal Corporation, funds have been allocated for the same, and he has made full efforts to elevate the Tiruchirappalli City Municipal Corporation to a premier corporation over other corporations at all levels.

Under this scheme, to facilitate easy access to medical treatment for the poor people living in urban areas, the government will allocate Rs. 944.00 lakhs,

a) 2 Health and Welfare centers each in 18 urban primary health centers of the corporation, a total of 36 centers will be constructed at an estimated cost of Rs. 900.00 lakhs.

b) The work of setting up a new Clinical Lab at East Boulevard Road Corporation Hospital and Woraiyur Corporation Hospital will be undertaken at an estimated cost of Rs. 22.00 lakhs each and at a total of Rs. 44.00 lakhs.

Under this project, it is planned to provide Uninterrupted water supply and sewerage services to the left-out areas and new residential areas. in Tiruchirappalli Corporation

a) It is planned to take up the work of laying a new 56.623 km long water supply distribution mains (estimated at Rs. 1650.00 lakhs).

The above works will be provide 177016 Water Supply House Service Connections at an estimated cost of Rs. 5311.00 lakhs by the year 2025, taking into account the new settlements and increasing population. A proposal has been sent to the government to carry out all the above works at a total estimated cost of Rs. 10707.00 lakhs.

d) Construction of a new sewage treatment plant

As per the announcement of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, a sewage treatment plant with a capacity of 120 MLD at a cost of Rs.20000.00 Lakhs with new technology will be constructed in Panchpur area.

e) Underground Sewerage Project Works for the Left-out Areas -

New under ground sewerage scheme will be implemented in the omitted areas at at an estimated cost of Rs. 21000.00 lakhs.

f) Improving Water Bodies

The work of improving the water bodies of Thamarai Kulam and Sathanur Sengulam within the limits of this Corporation will be carried out at a total estimated cost of Rs. 120.00 lakhs.

3.Sustainable Water Security Mission

Under this project, Panchpur Pond will be rejuvenated at an estimated cost of Rs. 30.00 lakhs (Government grant of Rs. 14.90 lakhs and Corporation funds of Rs. 15.10 lakhs).

4. Trichy sparkling with electric lights.

Steps have been taken to install 6266 new street lights of various capacities in all the streets and roads in the corporation area, including the newly formed residential areas and those that have no street lights, at an estimated cost of Rs. 1455.00 lakhs, with government grant. By implementing this scheme, street lights will be installed in all areas of the Tiruchirappalli City Municipal Corporation without Omission..

5. Fifteenth Finance Commission Recommendation Fund 2022-2023

Solid Waste Management Works following will be procured.

a) Under this scheme, 5 new heavy tipper vehicles - at an estimated cost of Rs. 150.00 lakhs

b).Jet radar heavy vehicle-4 numbers at an estimated cost of Rs. 300.00 lakhs

e) Compactor vehicle 2 numbers at an estimated cost of Rs. 76.00 lakhs

d) 1.1 Cu.m Compactor GI garbage bins 100 numbers at an estimated cost of Rs. 32.00 lakhs,

e) Procurement of 1500/750 HDPE containers with a capacity of 200/50 liters for the collection of segregated garbage from light vehicles at an estimated cost of Rs. 42.00 lakhs,

Action has been taken to procure the above vehicles and equipment for solid waste management work at an estimated cost of Rs. 600.00 lakhs.

Smart Storm Water Draiange

Under this project, a ward will be selected on a pilot basis and it is planned to carry out the work of repairing of all the storm water drains and canals in this ward with a cover to maintain hygiene, provide pedestrian walkways and prevent accidents on a multi-purpose basis at an estimated cost of Rs. 1000.00 lakhs. If this project is successful, steps will be taken to expand it to other wards.

Smart Roads

Under this project, it is planned to lay smart roads to prevent air pollution and accumulation of soil on the roadsides and it is proposed to construct bitumen/concrete roads and road rehabilitation works for the entire width of the main roads at a total estimated cost of Rs. 1700.00 lakhs.

6. Swachh Bharat Mission 2.0

Solid Waste Management Works Under this project,

1.To address the issue of management of "building demolition debris" (construction waste), Collection, transportation, amd management of C & D waste Center, under DIBFOT method, has been planned and to implement this work using advanced technology through public-private partnership (PPP) mode at an estimated cost of Rs.600 lakh."

2 Mechanized modern road cleaning vehicle (Road Sweeper) – 2 numbers at an estimated cost of Rs. 130.00 lakhs will be procured.

7. Panchappur Integrated Bus Terminal

The foundation stone for the Panjapur Integrated Bus Terminal, was laid by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu and the Minister of Municipal Administration and Rs. 14000.00 lakhs has been allocted under the Infrastructure and Amenities Fund. Further, the Corporation will provide Rs. 5000.00 lakhs as itsshare capital and Rs. 18779.00 lakhs as loan from the Tamil Nadu Urban Finance and Infrastructure Development Corporation to carry out the work of constructing a heavy vehicle terminal, a multi-purpose facility center and roads, storm water drains and other infrastructure facilities in the Panjapur area, for a total estimated cost of Rs. 37779.00 lakhs.



8.Smart City Mission

1. Construction of a library and knowledge center.

Under the Smart City Project, in order to improve the intellectual skills of students studying in school and college in these corporation areas and candidates preparing for competitive examinations for government and bank jobs, a new library and knowledge centre equipped with modern technology will be constructed in the Palakkarai area at an estimated cost of Rs. 250.00 lakhs and a knowledge centre will be constructed in the Kuthuppa Pallam area at an estimated cost of Rs. 250.00 lakhs

9. Infrastructure and Amenities work

1. Kajapettai stormwater drain

Construction of stormwater drain from Kajapettai road Moksha Rakini Madha Church to Uyyakkondan Canal under Ward Committee No. 2, Ward No. 50 will be undertaken at a cost of Rs. 200.00 lakh.

2. Cholamparai Retaining Wall

The work of construction of retaining wall, sewage collection well and Sluice system in Cholamparai Kudamurutti River Bed in Ward Committee No.5, Ward No. 8 will be executed at a cost of Rs. 246.00 lakhs.

3. Maris Theatre Over Bridge

The Maris theatre Railways Over Bridge, which was built in the 19th century, will be widened and modified to suit the current traffic volume at a cost of Rs. 4400.00 lakhs. The railway share amount of Rs. 2200.00 lakhs and the remaining amount of Rs. 2200.00 lakhs will be under this Scheme, and the work will be executed in the current year.

<u>10. Capital Grant Fund</u>

Work of setting up of Gas crematoriums

1) In order to avoid environmental pollution, the crematorium near Tanjore Road, SIT College of technology in Ward Committee No. 3, Ward No. 37 will be converted into a new LPG Gas-burning crematorium at a cost of Rs. 150.00 lakh

each and the crematorium at Panjapur in Ward Committee No. 4, Ward No. 62 will be converted into a new LPG Gas-burning crematorium at a cost of Rs. 150.00 each.

2) Proposal has been sent to the Government for consruction of Gasifier Crematorium in Ward Committee No. 5, Ward No. 24, Syndicate Bank colony and Ward No. 28, Thennur Annanagar Kuzhumikkarai area at the cost of Rs. 250.00 lakhs each, totaling to Rs. 500.00 lakhs.

General Fund

1. Stormwater Drainage Works

New storm water drain for the length of 3.35 km and the old storm water drain will be developed for the length of 3.50 km at a cost of Rs. 100.00 lakh. Further, desilting of culverts and storm drains will be executed at a cost of Rs. 100.00 lakh.

2. Water Supply Works

Laying of Water Supply Pumping mains for the length of 1.24 Kms and laying of Water Supply Distribution Mains for the length of 4.25 Kms with SCADA facilities from the newly constructed 5 Lakh Liter Capacity Overhead Water Tank, Peria Milagr Parai will be executed at an estimated cost of Rs.99.80 lakh.

3.Kollankulam Improvement Work

The Tiruchirappalli City Municipal Corporation has taken steps to provide a recreational environment for the people of Tiruchirappalli by providing a pathway for two wheelers, a pedestrian walkway, a playground for children and green spaces around the Kollankulam. The work will be carried out with government grant.

4. New Ward Office Service Centre

The construction of integrated service centers in all 65 wards will be carried out at an estimated cost of Rs. 650.00 lakhs at the rate of Rs. 10.00 lakhs each, so that the public can pay property tax, water charges, other charges related to the corporation in their wards, obtain birth and death registration and certificates, and obtain other certificates obtainable from the government, and so that the revenue assistant, sanitation supervisor, engineer's office and council members can receive grievance redressal petitions from the public in order to meet the needs of the people of the area.

5. Road Works

Road construction/maintenance works will be carried out in each ward, at a cost of Rs. 50.00 lakhs per ward, and a total of Rs. 3250.00 lakhs will be spent in all 65 wards. As per the details given below, 128 works will be carried out.

6. New Municipal Corporation Office Building:

A new building for the Tiruchirappalli Municipal Corporation central office is planned to be constructed at an estimated cost of Rs.4000.00 lakhs.

7. New Ward Committee Office Building:

A new building for the newly established Ward Committee Office No. 3 is planned to be constructed at an estimated cost of Rs.250.00 lakhs.

8. Ward Committee Funds:

Total Estimate of Rs.650.00 lakhs has been allocated for executing minor repair works in areas under five ward committees, with Rs.130.00 lakhs allocated per ward committee. The previous limit of Rs.50,000 per work has been increased to Rs.1,00,000 per work, and works can be undertaken through a resolution passed in the ward committee and based on contractual agreements.

9. Dog Sterilization Centers:

To control the birth rate of stray dogs causing public nuisance, a new dog sterilization center will be constructed in areas under four other ward committees at a total estimated cost of Rs.185.00 lakhs, as the existing center in Ward Committee No. 5 is insufficient.

10. Melapudur Foot Over Bridge:

To address the difficulties faced by school students and the general public in crossing the road near the railway bridge in the Melapudur area, necessary measures will be taken to construct a pedestrian foot over bridge in the area with government funding.

11. Solar-Powered Streetlights:

Of the 40,668 streetlights in Tiruchirappalli City Municipl Corporation, 5,000 will be converted to operate under solar power with government assistance. This initiative will be implemented in phases, in the coming years.

12. New Office Building for Ward Committee No. 5:

Currently, Ward Committee Office No. 5 operates from the rear side of Chinthamani Supermarket, within the Puthur overhead water tank compound. As this space is insufficient for management, a new office building will be constructed at the vacant site opposite to Chinthamani Supermarket.

13. Recreational Facilities Near Uraiyur Park:

The vacant sites near Woraiyur Uraiyur Park will be integrated and recreational facilities will be created this year for the public. .

14. New Bus Terminal in Srirangam:

Due to the increasing number of devotees visiting the historic Srirangam Ranganathar Temple, population increase and the growing multi-story residential buildingss, action will be taken to identify land and obtain government funding for construction of a modern bus terminal to meet the needs of residents and travelers, under the guidance of the Honorable Minister of Municipal Administration.

Educational Fund:

1. Development works will be undertaken to upgrade municipal school buildings to match private school standards. This includes the construction of smart classrooms, renovation of Anganwadi centers, and installation of modern toilet facilities in all municipal schools, at an estimated cost of Rs.2000.00 lakhs.

2. Currently, classes from Grades 1 to 12 are conducted in municipal schools. To increase student enrollment, proposals will be sent to the Education Department and the government to implement pre-primary classes (LKG & UKG), and appropriate follow-up actions will be taken.

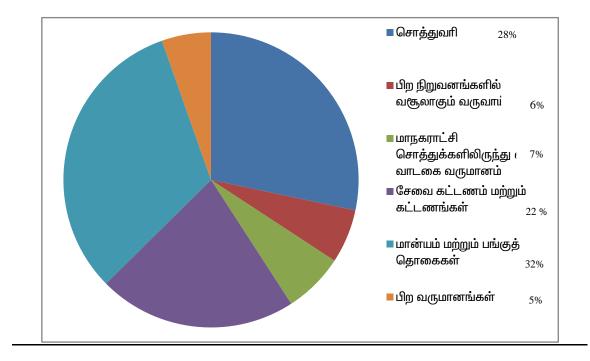

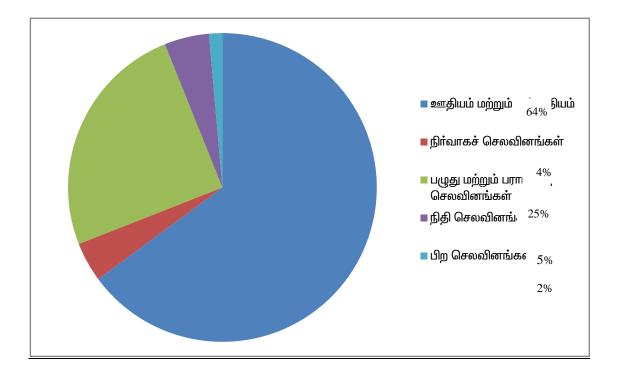
